

**INDUSTRIAL COMMISSION OF
CARNEYS POINT TOWNSHIP
MEETING MINUTES
AUGUST 11, 2014**

The meeting of the Carneys Point Industrial Commission was held on the above date at the time of **6:30 p.m.** Commission members Johnson, O'Donald, Racite, and Redfield were present. Mr. Bomba was not in attendance. Also present was J. Proffitt-Secretary.

Mrs. Racite called the meeting to order; read the **Open Public Meeting Act** and led the **Salute to the Flag**. **Roll call** was taken and a Quorum was established.

Mr. Redfield made a motion to approve the minutes from the regular Industrial Commission meeting held on July 14, 2014, seconded by Mr. O'Donald and all were in favor except Mrs. Racite abstained because she was not in attendance at that meeting.

There was no **Correspondence** and no **New Business** to discuss at this meeting. Mrs. Racite moved on to approve the **Bill List**. Mr. O'Donald motioned to approve the bill list, seconded by Ms. Johnson and all were in favor.

Mrs. Racite opened the meeting up for **Public participation**. With no comments or questions this portion was closed and back to the Commission.

Under **Old Business**: There was a lengthy discussion on Cory Sickles and the brochures he was fully paid to provide. At the end Mrs. Racite said she will contact Mr. Sickles to see if we can get a time frame for the finished product. She was sure he now had everything needed to finish this project. Mr. Bomba arrived at 6:45 p.m.

Mr. Bomba mentioned from last meeting the possibility of a technical center moving to New Jersey. He said he spoke to the Mayor and the Mayor is going to speak to a DuPont's representative. Mr. Bomba said he went to the University of Delaware and got the name and phone number for the owner of the Company. He did say he heard that Delaware City has also approached this company. Mr. Bomba said he has a meeting with the owner next Tuesday at the University of Delaware to discuss the opportunity of them relocating to New Jersey. Chambers Works can provide power and DuPont's' has fiber optics that go directly to Delaware. Mr. Bomba also mentioned speaking to John Burzichelli about this project. He said there is money available for new businesses coming to New Jersey. Mr. Bomba said he will let everyone know how the meeting goes next week.

Mr. Redfield brought up for discussion the website. He said months ago he mentioned how inadequate the website looks. If we are going to start handing out CD's for marketing the Township should be a site to go to for information. Mr. Bomba said this is the time to identify what needs we will be having for next year. Then go to the Mayor and Committee with a proposal for funding. Mrs. Racite mentioned the new site the Sewerage Authority has and they are linked to the Township's site. Mrs. Racite asked if anyone wants to attend the League of Municipalities to hand out CD's. Mr. Bomba said he has to check his schedule. At 7:04 pm Mr. Bomba left the meeting. There was some further discussion on the website.

With no further business to discuss, a motion was made by Mr. Redfield, seconded by Mr. O'Donald to adjourn. Motion passed with four affirmative votes. Meeting adjourned at 7:10 pm.
